By June 2020, MSB will increase the percentage of students performing at the Proficient and Advanced levels on the Missouri state assessment from 70% in CA (2015); 56% MA (2015) by 5% annually until 100% of all students perform at the Proficient or Advanced levels of the Missouri state assessment.
