

Unified English Braille Code: Overview of Changes

The Braille Authority of North America (BANA) is the rule setting body that establishes the codes and guidelines for braille use in North America. BANA has voted to adopt the Unified English Braille Code (UEB). UEB will replace the current literary braille code, English Braille American Edition on January 4, 2016. On **Wednesday, June 10, 2015**, Missouri School for the Blind will host, Mackenzie Savaiano, PhD., from University of Nebraska-Lincoln, at the Stoney Creek Hotel and Conference Center in Columbia, Missouri. She will present two two-hour sessions over viewing changes, sharing examples of UEB documents and providing opportunity for hands-on practice. **The morning session will run from 9:30-11:30 with a repeat afternoon session running from 1:00-3:00. Participants should bring their own equipment and practice materials, e.g., braillewriter, slate & stylus, notetaker, braille paper. To ensure sufficient space, please register by Thursday, May 28.**
