**What:** Missouri School for the Blind is pleased to offer ***Summer Explorations: Set Your Sights on Adventure***, a nine-day opportunity for students to explore concepts in leisure recreation and community-based orientation and mobility. During the first week of their ***Adventure***, students will visit a variety of St. Louis-area sites where they will review and develop their orientation and mobility and compensatory (VI) skills while exploring community-based leisure recreation activities.

MSB staff will design each activity and lesson to teach students to optimize their orientation and mobility and compensatory skills to access community-based leisure recreation opportunities and increase their independence within the expanded core curriculum.

The goal of ***Summer Explorations: Set Your Sights on Adventure*** is to introduce and help students explore a variety of community-based activities they may continue pursuing as leisure recreation into adulthood.
