What: **Mission to Mars** is an exciting and interactive opportunity for students to work alongside our experienced staff to develop skills for scientific inquiry which will allow them to increase their independence when participating in laboratory-based classes. Students will be well prepared for their quest to discover the mysteries of space as they are introduced to modified laboratory procedures, which will enable them to perform laboratory experiments.

During **Mission to Mars**, students will explore aspects of space exploration, our solar system and STEM careers while participating in activities including rocket design and construction, electronics, scientific experiments and elements of space exploration. Students will design and construct a Space Station, participate in a simulated voyage to Mars, and visit community-based STEM venues.
