Session 1: July 6-15

Middle School Explorations in Independence: MSB is pleased to offer **Explorations in Independence**, a two-week opportunity for Middle School-aged students to increase independence in the home. Students will participate in activities designed to facilitate increased independence in personal care, clothing management, personal food preparation, and household care and management.

High School FUNDamentals of Travel: MSB is pleased to offer **FUNDamentals of Travel**, a two-week opportunity for High School-aged students to explore concepts in leisure recreation and community-based orientation and mobility. During the first week of their travels, students will visit a variety of St. Louis-area sites where they will review and develop their orientation and mobility and compensatory (VI) skills while exploring community-based leisure recreation activities.

Session 2: July 18-29

MSB's Got Talent: MSB is pleased to offer **MSB's Got Talent**, a two-week opportunity for Middle and High School-aged students to be introduced to a wide variety of performing arts skills including those used in music, theater, art and more! The program will culminate in a talent show where students show off their skills!

Sessions 1 & 2: July 6-29

LIFE: Learning Independence From Experience (ages 16-21 years): MSB is pleased to offer **LIFE**, a four-week program for older students who are preparing for graduation and adulthood. **LIFE** is an immersion program designed to introduce students who are blind or visually impaired to the skills and concepts necessary to live, work and play independently in the community.
