





The Little Room is a space in which a child can explore his or her environment safely. Toys and objects are suspended from the ceiling with elastic cords, as in the photo on the right, and the child is free to explore and experiment with what she discovers while moving hands and legs. Items should be sturdy and it is preferable to avoid plastic. Items made of wood, fabric, and metal are much more interesting than plastic and provide more sensory feedback. Many people prefer to use real objects, such as a cup, toothbrush, spoon, small bells, etc. For children with some vision, items can be brightly colored. Comes with panels and harp.




